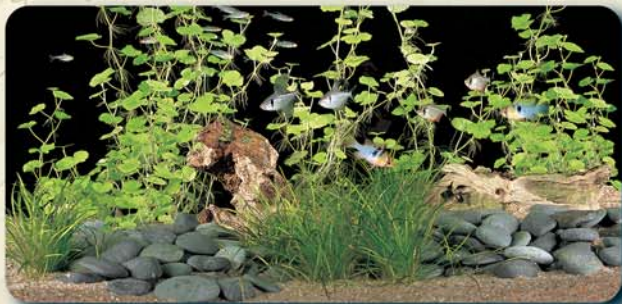

Undoubtedly, this continent is unsurpassed in terms of the variety of different, colorful and harmonious species of fish ideally combined with a captivating assortment of aquatic plants.

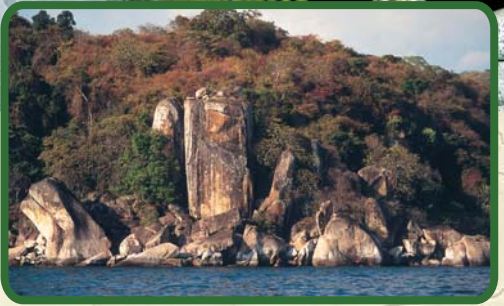

# Africa



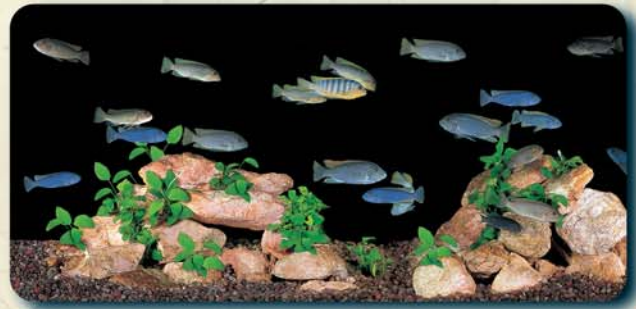
Lakes Malawi and Tanganyika are a cichlid lover's dream, with Lake Malawi in particular unrivaled by any other lake on earth in terms of the variety of cichlids that exist. Furthermore, many of these species are hardy and very easy to care for. The territorial nature and aggressiveness, however, do have implications with respect to aquarium set up, stocking rates and selection of species. The West and Central African area contains an assortment of famous aquarium species, such as the commonly known Jewel Cichlid, Kribensis Cichlid, Congo Tetra, African Blockhead Cichlid, African Red Eyed Tetra, African Glass Catfish, *Synodontis* catfish species and others.

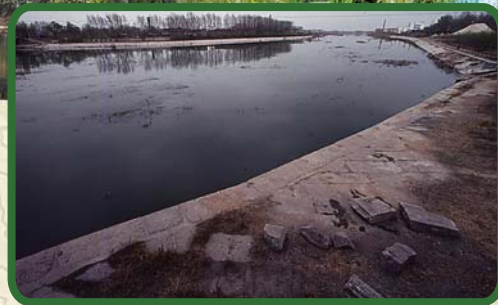

# Asia

Numerous species of ideal aquarium fish are available from various regions in Asia. Many of the biotopes are choked with dense plant populations and limited open water areas, making many Asian species suitable for smaller aquariums. Labyrinth fish offer many attractive aquarium species commonly known as Gouramis (example: *Trichogaster colisa*). These fish come in a variety of sizes, offering dwarf species as well, with remarkable coloration and fascinating reproductive methods (bubblenest builders and mouthbrooders).

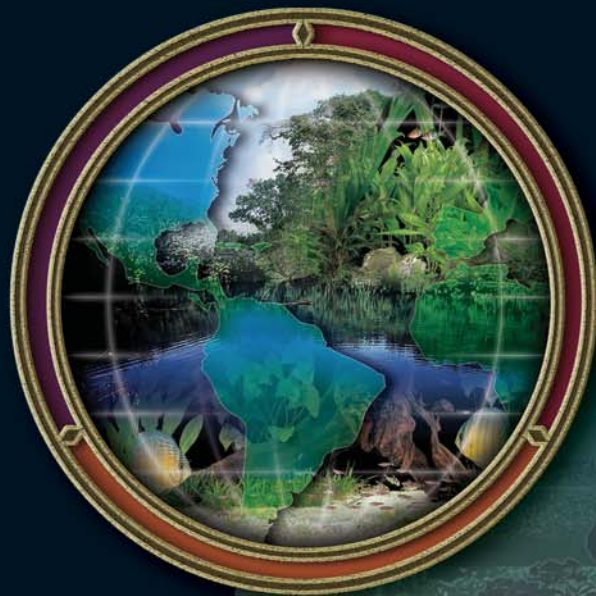
